## Axial Skeleton – Cranial Bones



Identify the following structures in the images below.

(Some structures may be visible in more than one image.)

zygomatic bone • maxilla • mandible • nasal bone • parietal bone • frontal bone  
supraorbital margin • supraorbital foramen • temporal bone • squamous portion  
mastoid portion • zygomatic process • external auditory meatus • mastoid process  
styloid process • stylomastoid foramen • ethmoid • inferior & middle nasal conchae  
coronal suture • sagittal suture • lambdoid suture • squamous suture • zygomatic arch




# Axial Skeleton – Cranial Bones

Identify the following structures in the images below.

(Some structures may be visible in more than one image.)

cribriform plate • olfactory foramina • crista galli • occipital bone • foramen magnum  
occipital condyles • external occipital protuberance • superior nuchal lines  
inferior nuchal lines • perpendicular plate
