

## Arteries

### I. External iliac a.

#### A. Deep circumflex iliac a. (under trunk)

anastomoses – superficial circumflex iliac, musculophrenic, subcostal, iliolumbar, 4th lumbar & superior gluteal a.

#### B. Femoral a. (L. thigh)

##### 1. Superficial epigastric a.

anastomoses – deep circumflex iliac, lateral circumflex femoral & superior gluteal a

##### 2. Superficial circumflex iliac a.

anastomoses – deep circumflex iliac, lateral circumflex femoral & superior gluteal a.

##### 3. Superficial external pudendal a.

anastomoses – branches of internal pudendal a.

##### 4. Deep external pudendal a.

anastomoses – branches of internal pudendal a.

##### 5. Descending genicular a. (L. geniculo, to bend, the knee)

anastomoses – medial superior genicular & medial inferior genicular a.

##### 6. Profunda femoral a. (L. deep)

###### a. Lateral circumflex femoral a.

###### i. ascending branch

anastomoses – superior gluteal, deep circumflex iliac, ascending branch of medial circumflex femoral, iliolumbar, 1st perforating & inferior gluteal

###### ii. descending branch

anastomoses – lateral superior genicular

###### iii. transverse branches

anastomoses – transverse branch of medial circumflex femoral, inferior gluteal & 1st perforating a.

###### b. Medial circumflex femoral a.

###### i. ascending branch

anastomoses – superior gluteal, inferior gluteal, ascending branch of lateral circumflex femoral, & 1st perforating a.

###### ii. transverse branch

anastomoses – inferior gluteal, transverse branch of lateral circumflex femoral & 1st perforating a.

###### iii. acetabular branch

anastomoses – obturator

###### c. Perforating branches

###### i. 1st

anastomoses – 2nd perforating, inferior gluteal, ascending & transverse branches of medial circumflex femoral, & ascending & transverse branches of lateral circumflex femoral a.

###### ii. 2nd

anastomoses – 1st perforating & 3rd perforating

###### iii. 3rd

anastomoses – 2nd perforating & 4th perforating

###### iv. 4th

anastomoses – 3rd perforating & popliteal

#### C. Popliteal a. (L. the ham of the knee)

anastomoses – 4th perforating a.

##### 1. Medial superior genicular a.

anastomoses – descending genicular, lateral superior genicular & medial inferior genicular a.

##### 2. Lateral superior genicular a.

anastomoses – descending branch of lateral circumflex femoral, medial superior genicular & lateral inferior genicular a.

##### 3. Medial sural a. (L. calf)

anastomoses – medial superior genicular, lateral inferior genicular, descending genicular, anterior

anastomoses – lateral superior genicular, medial inferior genicular, posterior tibial recurrent, anterior tibial recurrent & circumflex fibular a.
  8. Anterior tibial a. (L. large shinbone)

anastomoses – medial inferior genicular, lateral inferior genicular & circumflex fibular
    - b. Anterior medial malleolar a.
    - c. Anterior lateral malleolar a.  
anastomoses – perforating branch of peroneal & lateral tarsal a.
    - d. Dorsalis pedis a. (L. pes, foot)

anastomoses – anterior lateral malleolar & lateral tarsal a.
    - b. Circumflex fibular  
anastomoses – medial inferior genicular, lateral inferior genicular & anterior tibial recurrent a.
    - c. Nutrient artery of tibia
    - d. Medial plantar a.
    - e. Lateral plantar a.
      - i. Plantar arterial arch  
anastomoses – dorsalis pedis a.
        - plantar metatarsal & digital a.
- II. Internal iliac a.
- A. Superior gluteal a. (G. glutous, buttocks)  
anastomoses – inferior gluteal, lateral sacral, iliolumbar, superficial circumflex iliac, 1st perforating, deep circumflex iliac, ascending branch of lateral circumflex femoral & ascending branch of medial circumflex femoral a.
  - B. Inferior gluteal a.  
anastomoses – 1st perforating, ascending & transverse branches of lateral circumflex femoral, ascending & transverse branches of medial circumflex femoral, obturator, & superior gluteal a.
  - C. Obturator a.  
anastomoses – medial circumflex femoral (acetabular branch), inferior gluteal & iliolumbar a.
