

Ligaments

I. Pelvis

A. Iliolumbar

attachments – from transverse process of L5 & sacrum to iliac crest

B. Inguinal (L. inguen, groin)

attachments – from anterior superior iliac spine to pubic tubercle

1. Lacunar (L. lacus, pit, hollow or lake)

attachments – from medial end of inguinal ligament to medial end of pecten pubis

2. Pectineal

attachments – to pectin pubis

C. Pubic

1. Superior

attachments – to pubic tubercles

2. Arcuate

attachments – to lower borders of symphyseal pubic surfaces

D. Sacroiliac

1. Ventral

2. Dorsal

attachments – from lateral sacral crest to posterior superior iliac spine

3. Interosseous

attachments – between the articular surfaces

E. Sacrospinous

attachments – from ischial spine to lateral margin of sacrum

F. Sacrotuberous

attachments – from posterior iliac spine & lateral margin of sacrum to ischial tuberosity
