

## Ligaments

### I. Vertebral column

- A. Anterior longitudinal
  - attachments – to anterior surfaces of vertebral bodies and intervertebral discs
  - function – stabilizes vertebral column and prevents hyperextension
- B. Posterior longitudinal
  - attachments – to posterior surfaces of vertebral bodies and intervertebral discs
  - function – prevents hyperflexion of vertebral column
- C. Ligamentum flavum (L. *flavus*, yellow)
  - attachments – interconnect adjacent laminae
- D. Supraspinous
  - attachments – to apices of spinous processes C7 to sacrum
- E. Interspinous
  - attachments – interconnect adjacent spinous processes
- F. Ligamentum nuchae (nape, back of neck)
  - attachments – from C7 spinous process to external occipital protuberance
