

## Lymphatics

- I. Lymphatic trunks
  - A. Right jugular trunk
    - function – drains superficial and deep nodes into the right lymphatic duct
  - B. Left jugular trunk
    - function – drains superficial and deep nodes into the thoracic duct
- II. Lymph nodes
  - A. Superficial nodes of the head
    1. Occipital nodes
      - function – drains occipital scalp
    2. Mastoid (Retro-auricular) nodes
      - function – drains ear and adjacent scalp
    3. Parotid nodes (G. para, beside + ous, ear)
      - function – drains ear, face, nose and scalp
    4. Buccal (facial) nodes (L. cheek)
      - function – drains nose and adjacent face
  - B. Superficial nodes of the neck
    1. Retropharyngeal nodes
      - function – drains nasopharynx and atlanto-occipital & atlantoaxial joints
    2. Submandibular nodes
      - function – drains face, tongue, mouth, nose and palate
    3. Submental nodes
      - function – drains central lower lip
    4. Anterior cervical nodes (along larynx and trachea)
      - function – drains anterior neck
    5. Lateral cervical nodes (along accessory nerve)
      - function – drains lateral neck
  - C. Deep cervical nodes
    1. Superior nodes
      - function – drains larynx, pharynx, posterior palate, posterior tongue, and occipital, retro-auricular, parotid, buccal, retropharyngeal & submandibular nodes
    2. Inferior nodes
      - function – drains the trachea, thyroid, esophagus, and submental, anterior neck, lateral neck & superior deep cervical nodes
